- Teaches content and skills in all subject areas utilizing curriculum designated by ICS through the Common Core Standards and Georgia Standards of Excellence
- Develops weekly lesson plans and curriculum maps in conjunction with their grade level colleagues
- Evaluates academic and social growth of students (pre-post tests), analyzes data, prepares report cards, keeps appropriate records (to include attendance reports, checklists, and other recordkeeping activities) as necessary.
- Evaluates each student's progress in meeting the Common Core and Georgia Standards of Excellence.
- Establishes and maintains standards of student behavior needed to provide an orderly, productive, and safe classroom environment.
- Administers mandated tests in accordance with the testing department of ICS and the DeKalb County School District
- Proven track record of student success on formative, summative and standardized tests as well as impacting student social and emotional well-being.

**Minimum Qualifications:** Must hold a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree with Early Childhood Education Certification (P-5) from the Georgia Professional Standards Commission. Preferable to also have experience with teaching math to a variety of learning levels.
