



## **IBPYP English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) Teacher (K-5)**

**Job Summary:** The ESOL Teacher will be responsible for providing dynamic classroom instruction to students through a rigorous and holistic educational model.

### **Essential Duties:**

- Teach content and English Language Arts skills in all grade levels K-5 through the Georgia Performance Standards along with the effective implementation of the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (IBPYP)
- Develop weekly lesson plans and curriculum maps in conjunction with their grade level and ESOL colleagues
- Evaluate academic and social growth of students (pre-post assessments), analyze data, prepare report cards, keep appropriate records (to include attendance reports, checklists, and other recordkeeping activities) as necessary
- Create and maintain documents and files for individual students as mandated by the DeKalb County School District EL Program
- Evaluate each student's progress in meeting the Georgia Standards of Excellence.
- Establish and maintain standards of student behavior needed to provide an orderly, productive, and safe classroom environment
- Identify student's needs and cooperate with other professional staff members to address issues such as counseling concerns, SST process, School-Within-a-School (SWS)
- Communicate with homeroom teachers, parents and school counselors on student progress.
- Participate in staff meetings and support student activities (i.e. IB Exhibition, Drama, and athletics)
- Administer mandated tests in accordance with the testing department of ICS and the DeKalb County School District
- Teach through a student centered, inquiry-based creative approach
- Demonstrate a track record of student success on formative, summative and standardized tests as well as impacting student social and emotional well-being
- Develop a multicultural learning community that emphasizes respect for diversity
- Engage with the community and work with translators and social service providers to help ensure a continuum of support between the home and school

**Minimum Qualifications:** Must hold a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree with Early Childhood Education Certification (P-5) and ESOL Endorsement from the Georgia Professional Standards Commission. Preferable to also have experience with the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (IBPYP) and/or inquiry-based learning.
